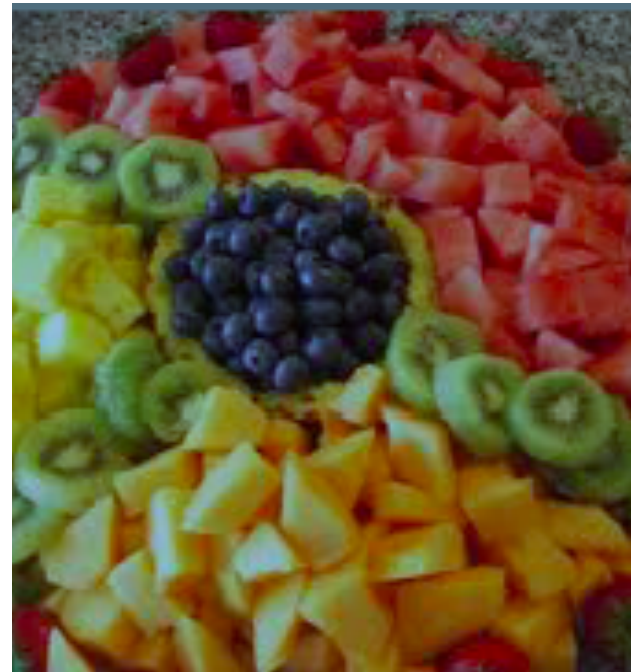
# Disciplinary Research

Where the focus is on one area of study of the topic



# Multidisciplinary Research

Where the topic is studied independently and/or sequentially within multiple disciplines, often focusing on different parts of the problem and retaining disciplinary separation



# Interdisciplinary Research

Where the topic is studied jointly and interactively by two or more areas of study, with each providing a perspective that other areas consider and allow to influence their work



# Transdisciplinary Research

Where concepts and methods and theories from different areas are blended into a single overarching framework and the result is so integrative that they may even end up forming an entire new field of study.
